SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. RULES

Races will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS), as amended by Appendix B Windsurfing Competition Rules.

2. NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

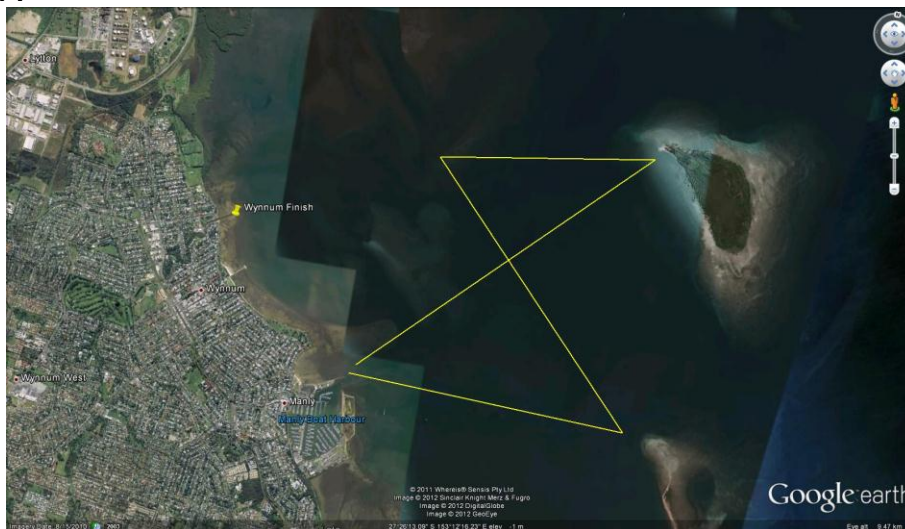
Notice to Competitors will be posted on the Official Notice Board located near the Registration desk at the venue.

3. CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Any change to the Sailing Instructions will be posted on the Official Notice Board not less than 30 minutes before the first race in which such change will take effect.

4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

**For boards with upwind ability we will have a social mini marathon kicking off at 12.30 pm
Course below .**



11.2 A board shall not sail through the finishing line except when finishing.

11. PENALTIES

Rule 44.2 – 360 degree turn will apply (refer B2.1(c)).

12. TIME LIMITS

The time limit for all races will be 15 minutes. Boards finishing outside the time limit will be scored DNF.

13. PROTESTS

14.1 Competitors intending to protest shall inform the finishing boat of their intention at the time of finishing or retiring, and provide the sail number(s) of the competitor(s) being protested and any witnesses involved (Amends RRS 61).

14.2 The protest time limit is 30 minutes after the last board has finished in the last race of the day.

14. SCORING

15.1 Scoring will be in accordance with RRS B8.2 – Slalom races.

15.2 Eight (8) races are scheduled, of which three (3) shall be completed to constitute a series.

15.3 When only three (3) races can be completed, a board's score shall be the sum of its scores for all races.

15. SAFETY REGULATIONS

16.1 All skippers shall SIGN ON before racing and SIGN OFF at the earliest possible time after the completion of racing, but no later than 30 minutes after the last competitor has finished in the last race of the day. Sign On/Sign Off forms will be available at the Registration desk.

16.2 The skipper of a board that retires or does not intend to continue racing, is required to SIGN OFF immediately on return to shore. Failure to comply with this instruction may result in protest and subsequent disqualification.

16.3 A board which retires from a race shall, if reasonably practicable, pass close enough to a race committee vessel or patrol boat to signal its retirement.

16.4 A competitor who fails to wear an approved buoyancy vest or harness while racing, will be scored DNS. The requirement of RRS 40 to display flag Y will not apply.

16.5 Clothing – Refer RRS 43 & B2.1(b)

16. IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS

All competing boards shall have sail numbers correctly displayed at all times.

17. DISCLAIMER

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4 – Decision to Race.

The organizing authority shall not be liable for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

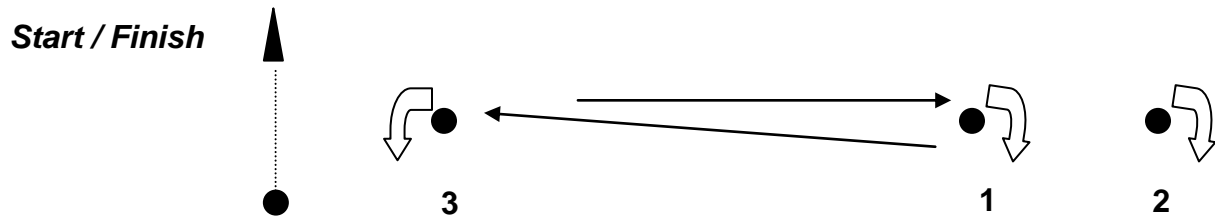
